Important Topic Vocabulary	
country	A large area of land that has its own government.
city	A very large town where lots of people live and work.
capital city	A city that a country is ruled from. London is the capital city of England
town	A place where people live that usually has a market.
village	A small place where people live usually surrounded by fields.
countryside	Land that has fields or a farm.
landmark	An important building or place.
