• The names of the Capital Cities, their rivers and bodies of water surrounding the United Kingdom (UK):







European Countries

A small number of these countries on the continent of Europe are transcontinental. This means they are considered to be part of both Europe and Asia.


For this topic, we need to know the location of the following countries: France, Germany, Spain, Italy, Belgium, Russia, Iceland and Poland.
