


Year 1 Term 1.2

Important Topic Vocabulary			
weather	How hot, cold, windy, wet or dry it is outside.		
climate	What the weather is usually like in a given place over a long time.		
temperature	How hot or cold it is.		
season	These are the 4 parts of the year that have particular weather patterns and hours of daylight.		
daylight	Light from the Sun.		
hibernate	When animals sleep through winter and wake up in spring		
symbol	A picture which has a meaning.

- I know what the weather feels like; rain is wet and the sun is warm
- I know that snow is cold and melts in the warm (think about the snowy weather we had last winter)
