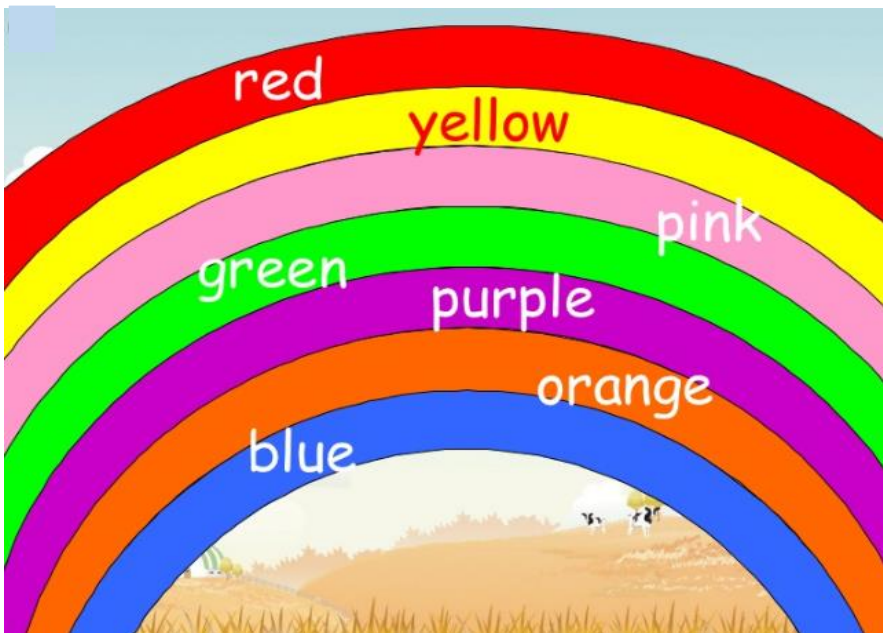


### What should I already know?

sun

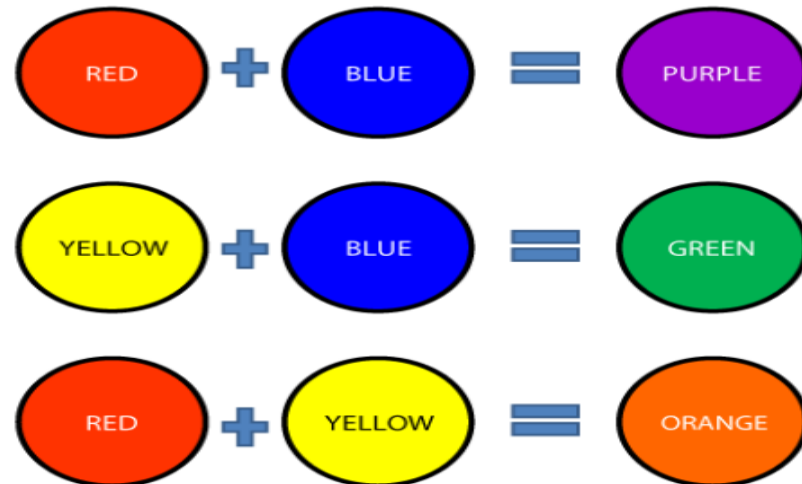


stars
