Despite the rain, a wonderful time was had by all who attended our Summer Fair. Families had the opportunity to buy food, cakes, play games and even be part of our photo booth!

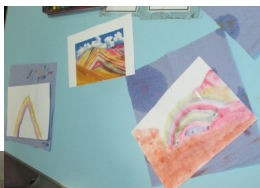
Thank you again to our wonderful home cooks who made food for us to sell at the fair – it was definitely one of our most popular stalls!
