4. Water the seeds.

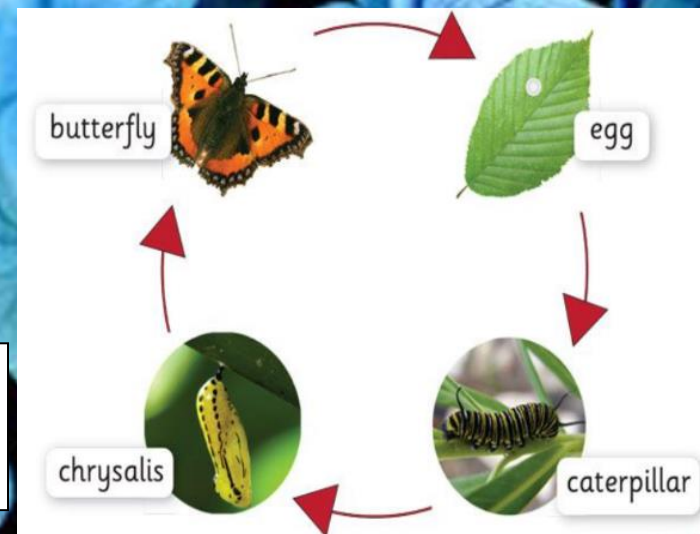


What will grow?

caterpillar- A caterpillar is an insect that eats plants and turns into a butterfly.

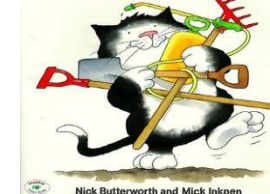
chrysalis- The hard covering made by a caterpillar.

butterfly- An insect with wings and a thin body.

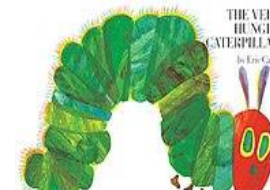
seed- The part a plant grows from.

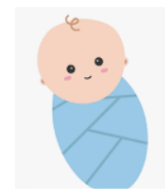
