

Winter

What do I already know?

- Some weather words like sunny, windy, snowy, rainy and cloudy.
- The names of some winter clothes like jumper, hat, scarf, gloves, coat and wellies.
- There are 4 seasons in the year.

Important Words -

season – A part of the year when the weather changes.

weather – What the sky and the air are like outside, such as cold and cloudy.

temperature – A measurement of how hot or cold something is.

freezing – When water (liquid) is cooled, it changes to ice (solid). This change is called freezing.

melting – When ice (solid) is heated, it changes to water (liquid). This change is called melting.

thawing – The process of ice, snow, or another frozen substance becoming liquid or soft as a result of warming up.

Winter

Winter is the seasons that follows on from Autumn.

What changes happen during winter?

- Snow falls in the winter.
- Trees and plants stop growing.
- Leaves fall off the trees, leaving them bare.
- The weather gets colder because the temperature is lower.
- Nights are longer in winter.
- Some animals hibernate.



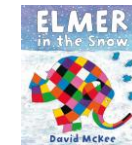
Ice:

In Winter sources of water freeze and melt. This is known as thawing. Ice is solid and made up of frozen water.

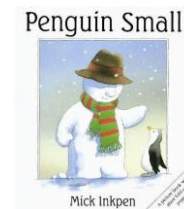

Antarctica:

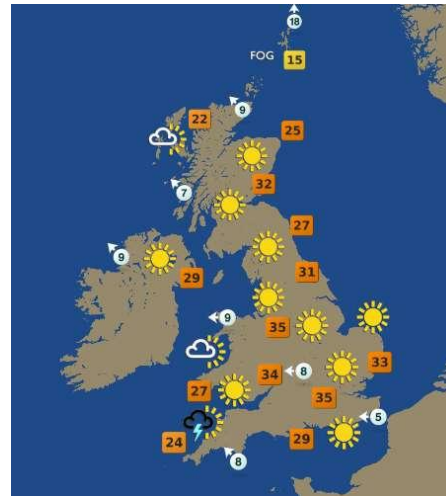
Antarctica is a continent. It is a large solid area of land that is an icy desert. It has very little rainfall. Antarctica is the coldest and windiest continent on Earth.
