## Uniform edition

We believe school uniform plays a key role in **promoting pride**, **self-confidence**, **and a feeling of belonging**. These factors contribute to our pupils' wellbeing and removes any pressures of deciding what to wear and asking parents for expensive fashion items for school wear.

We encourage pupils to feel proud to be part of our school family and this includes the wearing of correct uniform. We are also mindful of the majority of our families culture and traditions, whilst being part of a community school in Oldham.

White short, three-quarter or long-sleeved polo shirts and cotton shirts are available to buy. This means children can take their sweatshirt off when it is warm and still be covered.

Girls can wear grey or black leggings under their skirt or pinafore but not leggings on their own.

Children who wear a head scarf need a pull on one for health and safety reasons. No pins are allowed.

Stud earrings, a tabij and a sensible watch may be worn. All jewellery must be removed for all PE and swimming lessons.

We are mindful of costs and although we have branded PE t-shirts and a hoody, children can wear a collared polo shirt in their house colour and their school sweatshirt or cardigan.

All clothing including coats, need to be labelled with your child's name and class. This is the only way your lost items can be returned to you.

If you have any concerns with the cost of uniform, please come and speak to a member of the office staff or speak to one of the Strategy Team who are available every day, at the school gates, before and after school.

All our uniform is available at Debonaire in Oldham and non-branded items are stocked at Asda, Tesco and all main supermarkets.

## Burnley Brow School Uniform

Purple sweatshirt or cardigan.

A short, three-quarter or long-sleeved white polo shirt. Year 6 can wear a white short, three quarter or long sleeved cotton shirt and a school tie.

Trousers or a grey skirt/pinafore with black/grey leggings, black, grey or white tights or black, grey or white socks. Leggings cannot be worn on their own.

## A pull on plain head scarf in **purple, black or white.**

On hot days children can wear shorts or a purple summer dress. They can leave their sweatshirts at home.





Our indoor PE uniform

Polo shirts in your child's house colour with black leggings, black jogging bottoms or black shorts.

Black pumps with brown soles. These should be named and kept in school in a drawstring bag on your child's peg.

Children must not wear a sweatshirt or hoody for indoor PE.

Long sleeved polo shirts for PE should be available from January 2025.

Polo shirts in your child's house colour with black leggings, black jogging bottoms or black shorts (as above) and trainers. A purple zip-up hoody (with logo available) or a school branded sweatshirt or cardigan.
